# Charter Commission

The Charter Commission's function is to continue to study the local charter and government. State law and Wayzata's Charter require a complete and active Charter Commission. It is essential to the process of revising, updating and amending the City's Charter. The Commission meets annually or as necessary. Commissioners have a background and interest in how local governments operate and are appointed by the District Court after council recommendations. The Chief Judge appoints new members every two years. The Commission is comprised of between seven and fifteen members who serve four-year terms. Commissioners must be a qualified voter of the City.

The charter commission did not have any council driven initiatives in 2020.
